


**TOWN OF COHASSET  
BOARD OF SELECTMEN**

**RULES GOVERNING ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL LIQUOR LICENSES**

The following rules shall govern the issuance of special liquor licenses (so-called "one-day licenses) in the Town of Cohasset and are consistent with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 138, Section 14:

1. The Board of Selectmen may grant special licenses for the sale of wine and malt beverages to a responsible manager of any profit and non-profit organization.
2. The Board of Selectmen may grant special licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages to non-profit organizations only.
3. No person may be granted special licenses for more than a total of 30 days per calendar year and no special license may be granted to any person while his/her application for an annual license under Section 12 of Chapter 138 is pending before the licensing authorities.
4. No more than one license can be issued for a premises at one time, thus a special license may not be issued for use in a premises already licensed under Chapter 138.
5. Persons and organizations holding a special license issued by the Board of Selectmen are responsible for full compliance with all laws governing the sale of alcoholic beverages in Massachusetts, including but not limited to laws pertaining to sale of alcoholic beverages to minors and intoxicated persons.
6. All applications for special licenses are to be submitted to the Board of Selectmen no less than 21 days before the date of the event for which the special license is sought.
