The undersigned acknowledges and agrees to the following:

- 1) No work shall commence until the Sewer Commissioners has issued a Permit for the Sewer Service Connection.
- 2) The owner shall facilitate through its installer prior to connection to the Municipal Sewer Stub, that the contractor shall water jet the stub all the way to the main line to clear any sediment, debris or grease, which may have accumulated in the stub.
- 3) The owner shall schedule and facilitate the execution of an interior and exterior inspection of all proposed sanitary piping and the final connection by the Sewer Commission’s inspector prior to any backfilling of the service connection and prior to commencing any discharge to the system. Please note: Scheduling must be done at least 48 hours prior to actual need.
- 4) The owner, through its installer, shall provide pressure testing of the new installation, as deemed necessary by the Sewer Commission’s inspector, and certify in writing that the sewer connection is watertight and complies with Commission/State standards relative to construction.
- 5) The Sewer Commission shall provide a copy of this form to the Board of Health for their use and tracking. The owner shall comply with all Board of Health requirements relative to septic system decommissioning or otherwise and shall comply with all other applicable local, State and Federal regulations governing the installation and related construction activity.
- 6) The owner shall ensure and maintain that only domestic wastewater enters the sewer system and that no drainage water, sump pump discharges, roof drainage or other extraneous flows enter the system.
- 7) If the Sewer Commission deems that an engineering review is required due to the complexity of the connection, the owner agrees to pay all costs up front prior to the processing of this application. In such instances, a written estimated cost will be provided to the owner for said engineering review.
