Cohasset Grinder Pump Users

There are still many cases of foreign objects clogging sewer pumps, and this notice is to remind Cohasset grinder pump users that only normal toilet and garbage disposer waste should be discharged to the pumping units. As we previously advised our users, it is necessary for us to backcharge them for the Town's \$85 - \$150 cost for service calls to remove foreign objects. The following objects have caused repeated service calls: tampons, dental floss, baby wipes, Q-Tips. In addition, the following objects may also clog the pumps: bones, diapers, cloth, glass, metal, nuts, plastic, rags, rope, rubber, sand, sanitary napkins, shells, and towels.

Please also remember that these are electrically powered units and that the system is designated for the pumping of only sanitary wastewater. Fuels, flammable liquids, solvents, pesticides, poisons, paint, paint thinner, and other hazardous chemicals should never be discharged to the system and it is illegal to do so.
